

# Art 2021 Winter

**5-7 Year Olds** - Students rotate to art once a week for 30 minutes.



**Snowmen at Night-** watercolor study of snowmen and snowwomen

- Students read the book *Snowmen at Night* by Caralyn Buehner, illustrated by Mark Buehner.
- Students used a washable marker technique to show shading and value.
- Students used a wax resist technique to show movement with wind and snowflakes.
- Students learned watercolor techniques to create a background.

**Clay Plaque With First Initial-** students made a plaque with their first initial out of clay

- Students read the book *Chicka Chicka Boom Boom* by Bill Martin Jr. and John Archambault.
- Students used cookie cutters to create a positive space shape.
- Students created relief and recessed areas in their clay by using shoe imprints and various textured items to create imprints.
- Students used the coil method to create their first initial.
- Students learned how to score and slip to create a bond with clay.
- Students used a variety of painting methods to emphasise their relief patterns.
- Students embellished with glitter and beads.
- Students used pipe cleaners to secure a hook on their plaque.
