8-10 Year Olds - Students rotate to art for two weeks, four days a week for 45 minutes a day, then music for two weeks and movement for two weeks.



Navajo Weaving

- Artwork was inspired by numerous legends and tales told by Navajo, Lakota and Pueblo Indians: *The Goat in the Rug by Geraldine*, *Spider Woman Teaches the Navajo*, *Iktom and the Ducks*, *Iktomi's Blanket*, *Arrow to the Sun*, *Kokopelli Drum In The Belly*, *The Girl Who Loved Wild Horses*.
- Students discussed and analyzed the history and contemporary use of weaving in the Navajo culture.
- Students designed and created a weaving inspired by Navajo traditions.
- Students learned various weaving techniques and processes.
- Students learned the process of taking a weaving off of a loom and solved ways in which to display their work.
- Students reflected on their product and process through a written artist statement.
