Ancient Indus River Valley Seals Logo Design







- Students studied the ancient Indus River Valley Seals and explored their uses for status, trading and branding.
- Students created their own modern day logo with an emphasis on identity and personal connection to a certain object which best represents them.
- Students used the process of plaster casting to create a surface to carve into.
- Students used graphite transfer method to carve their designs into plaster.
- Students pressed their designs into sculpey to replicate the ancient River Valley Seals.
- Students used foam board to create printing blocks with their logo designs.
- Students used the printmaking process to create ten unified prints.

Visual Storytelling in progress- inspired by black artists and illustrators

- Students are exploring how 14 different black artists and illustrators told their stories through their artwork.
- Students are analyzing how these artists created meaning through different visual narratives and techniques.
- Students are creating their own stories using a variety of materials and narrative strategies inspired by the style of art represented by various black artists and illustrators.
- Students are conducting research on black artists and illustrators.
- Students will reflect on their product and process through a written artist statement.
