CLASSROOM SUPPLY LIST

2021-2022 SCHOOL YEAR

PRESCHOOL (Ages 3-5)

- A gift card of at least \$25. Store to be determined in class letter coming soon.
- 2 rolls of paper towels

LOWER ELEMENTARY (Ages 5-7)

- \$25 minimum gift card to Target or Walmart
- 2 rolls of paper towels
- \$6 for scholastic

MIDDLE ELEMENTARY (Ages 7-9)

- One backpack for carrying back and forth to school. It should be big enough for a folder, a water bottle, and a lunch box but not so big that it becomes easily cluttered and hard to carry or find things in it. Nothing with wheels, please.
- A lunch box and a water bottle
- 2-3 clean masks per day. The masks should be snug enough that your child does not need to continuously reposition and adjust. They should also be clearly labeled with your child's name and have a distinct inside/outside.
- Indoor shoes (such as crocs or slippers) that are quick and easy for your child to get on and off. *Please label them; we will keep them in the classroom throughout the school year.* If you also want to send in mud boots to keep at school, that is fine; just be sure to label them, too.
- A ziplock bag containing a complete change of seasonally appropriate clothing for your child. *Please label them; we will keep them in the classroom throughout the school year.*
- Sunscreen and/or bug spray and/or sunhat, labeled with your child's name (optional)
- 10-12 lead/graphite pencils with erasers
- 4-6 glue sticks
- A set of 10-24 colored pencils (please no more than 24, space is limited)
- A set of 10-24 washable magic markers (please no more than 24, space is limited)
- A yoga mat, something 3-5mm thick only. We will use this mat both inside and outside the classroom.
- We will be working with money every day. Please send in the following coins in a
- Ziplock bag labeled with your child's name.
 - 4 quarters

- 10 dimes
- 20 nickels
- 15 pennies
- \$15-20 gift card to Target or Kroger or Amazon for classroom supplies. Rather than having to store dozens of boxes of tissues, wipes, hand sanitizers, paper towels, and other similar “consumable” supplies, we will use these gift cards to resupply our classroom as the year goes on.

UPPER ELEMENTARY (Ages 8-10)

- One (1) \$25 gift card (Kroger, Amazon, Target, Walmart)
- One notebook for Spanish

MIDDLE SCHOOL

- A nutritious midday snack and lunch, packed in a labeled lunch bag
- Labeled water bottle-- required, as water fountains will not be in use except to refill bottles
- Daily mask (students may want to keep a back-up with them)
- Yoga mat- may be reused from last year.
- Pencil pouch with pens, pencils, erasers, markers, scissors and highlighters (students may use their pouch from last year). We will limit shared supplies this year.
- Art pouch with two pencils, pencil sharpener, watercolor pencils and glue stick (may be reused from last year)
- Student planner-- first and second years should have a physical planner; third and fourth years may use physical or digital planner.
- 3 prong pocket folder for music class
- Graph composition book for math
- 1 notebook for Spanish

Personal device (laptops work better than tablets). Students should be familiar with their devices; they will need to bring it to and from school each day. Please encourage students to charge their device each evening; they may also want to carry charging cords with them. Devices are available for long-term check out from school; please email Nicole if needed.

- Personal headphones
